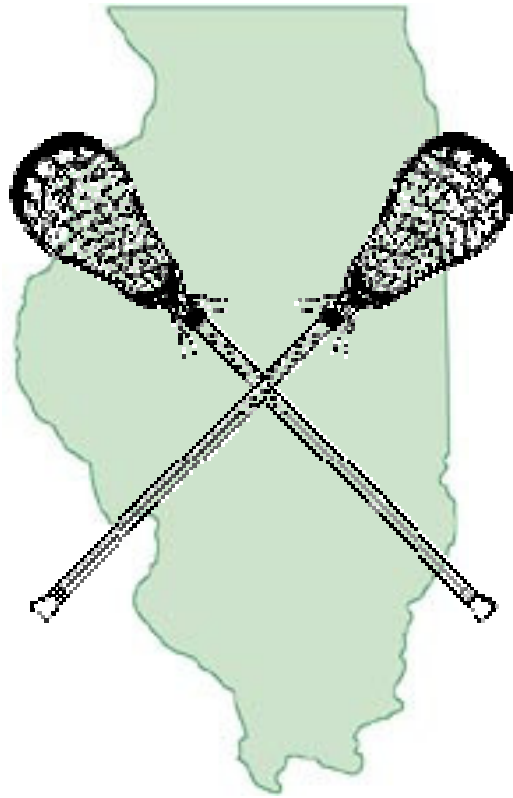

Only one ticket is necessary for the whole afternoon. Hand stamps will be used to allow exit and re-entry.

Team Hosts

Teams will be assigned a team host that will direct them to the locker room facilities and help out with any team needs while they are at Palatine HS.

Warm-ups

Warm-ups will begin at 2:30 p.m. and conclude at 3:25 p.m. The Warm-ups for the 2nd game will begin at 5:00 on a back field and then a 30 minute warm-up on the stadium.

All teams will return to their respective benches with five (5) minutes before the game for team introduction and the *National Anthem*. (3:25p.m. & 5:55p.m.)

Medical Arrangements

Athletic training staff from Palatine High School will be on site prior to, and during the game to tend to any needs from either team.

The Palatine paramedics are also available on call as needed.

If a school brings their own trainer or physician, they must have a *Trainers Pass* to gain admission and occupy a place on the field.

Participation Passes

In an effort to maintain a professional sideline environment, each team advancing to the State Championship will be issued the following field passes:

Coaching Staff	(5)
School Administration	(2)
Medical Staff	(1)
Press/Photographer	(2)

Persons not displaying a pass will be asked to leave the playing area.

Media Requirements

Local media must show proper credentials to enter the stadium. There will be facilities available at Palatine High School for media's needs.

School Reporters, Photographers, and/or Video Operators

Each school participating in the State Championship may be represented by a student reporter and photographer for the school newspaper and/or yearbook. Two (2) passes will be issued to the each competing school to allow bearer game privileges. Video taping is allowed from East side press boxes only.

TV Broadcast

Comcast will videotape and broadcast both championship games on their "Game of the Week" segments on Sunday, June 3, 2012. The Lacrosse Cup game will be aired at 12:00PM and the State Championship game will be aired at 4:00PM.

Banners/Signs

Banners and signs will be permitted, providing they are in good taste and do not obstruct anyone's view. Noisemakers are permitted, provided they do not interfere with the play of the game.

Stadium Seating and Concessions

Spectator seating will be designated on the West side of the stadium only (parking lot). Concessions will be made available.

Parking

Team buses can unload players at the main gates directly behind the West stadium bleachers. Bus parking is made available in the main parking lot along the tennis courts.

Fan buses can park and unload spectators in the main parking lot.

Free parking will be available for spectators in the stadium and school lot.

Restrictions

IHSA rules and Palatine public safety rules apply to the event. No fires, barbecues or alcohol will be allowed in or around the stadium and parking lots. Restrictions will be enforced by the Palatine police department.

Severe Weather Conditions

In case of severe weather conditions prior to, or during the game, teams will be moved to respective locker rooms located at the field building. Spectators will be asked to remove themselves from the bleachers and return to the safety of their automobiles.

Trophy Presentation

Immediately following handshake, teams should return to their respective benches for trophy presentation. Captains representing the runners-up will be awarded their trophy first, followed by captains from the winning team.
