

2015 IHSLA Championship Day Information Sheet

- Date: Saturday, May 30, 2015
- Game Times:
 - Lacrosse Cup – 3:30pm
 - State Championship Game – 6:00pm
- Venue: Naperville Central High School, Memorial Stadium
Hillside Avenue
Naperville, IL 60540
- Gates open at 2:00 PM
- Tickets: \$6 per person:
 - IHSLA registered officials have been authorized to sit in the East bleachers and will enter through the East Entrance at the northeast corner of the stadium. Only one ticket is necessary for the whole afternoon. There will be no PASS OUTS.
- Parking: Free parking will be available in all campus parking lots.
 - Naperville Police will ticket patrons who do not adhere to local parking ordinances.
 - There will be parking for handicap, VIP's and game officials only, directly behind the press box.
 - Restrictions: IHSA rules and Naperville District 203 rules apply to the event. No fires, barbecues or alcohol will be allowed in or around the stadium and parking lots. The entire campus is no smoking.
 - Restrictions will be enforced by the Naperville Staff and Naperville Police Department.
- Concessions: Food and drinks will be available at the stadium for purchase after 2:30 pm
- Media: Field passes are required for media members and photographers desiring access to field-level locations. There will be a media table just inside the stadium gates at which one can request a lanyard and field access. Please be ready to show ID and affiliation. Field access will be restricted to the west side of the field only.
- Officiating: Referees will be contracted and assigned by the IHSLA. The scoring table and horn/penalty clock will be staffed by Naperville Central personnel. There is no need for participating teams to provide volunteers for the scoring table.
- Teams will be allowed into the Main Building locker rooms (upon advance request) one hour prior to game time. Teams will be asked to bring all personal and game gear to their respective sideline when they exit their locker room. They will have access to halftime/pre game rooms on the field. Not available post game.
- Training Staff: Naperville Central's Sports Medicine Staff will work both games.
- Weather: Naperville Central will operate under the IHSA (Illinois High School Association) guidelines for dealing with hazardous weather conditions.
- Press box- No Team coaches allowed in the press box during games.
- Directions to Naperville Central Campus:

 - I-88 west to Rt. 59 south
 - Turn left on Aurora Avenue
 - **From the South:**
 - I-294 to I-88 west
 - Exit at Rt. 59 south
 - Turn left on Aurora Avenue

 - Exit Rt. 59 south
 - Turn left onto Aurora Avenue
